Feel the Freedom

Driving is such a major part of our lives. In most areas, driving is practically a requirement.

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration keeps a lot of statistics on teen drivers involved in DUIs and DUI-related fatalities.

Did you know that 7% of all licensed drivers are between 15 and 20 years old, but 15% of all fatal crashes involve the same age group? According to these numbers, you are actually twice as likely to die in a car crash than adults 21 and over.

Those Numbers Don't Lie

And while most 'grown-ups' may not know those exact numbers, they all recognize the extra risk you face when you drive.
